Teen Reviewers and Critics (TRaC) and Arts Admin Intern

The Summer Teen Reviewers and Critics Program (TRaC) is a free 4-week program for high school students from all over New York and New Jersey to explore the arts in NYC while expanding critical thinking and writing skills. The TRaC Summer Intern will collaborate with the TRaC Program Manager to gain valuable skills, knowledge, and hands-on experience in arts education and administration. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Assist teaching artists during virtual workshops and researching content for various art forms
- Write and edit responses to arts experiences
- Assist with digital marketing efforts, on social media platforms and through our High5 Newsletter
- Update digital and paper archives;
- Data entry and developing reports on teen experiences in programs;
- Contribute to creating a welcoming and inclusive environment for teen participants and staff

Applicant should be:

- 18 years or older
- Eager to learn about the administrative and teaching practices that support youth development
- Responsible and mature individual who work well independently and in teams

Schedule: July 6 – August 7, 2020; minimum 20 hours per week, 5 weeks, 4 days per week, must commit to a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday schedule (with Mondays and Fridays depending on your availability)
